North Middletown Elementary is located in rural Bourbon County in the city of North Middletown. According to the 2020 Census, the total population for North Middletown was 626. The poverty rate for North Middletown is 15.83% with an average income for a household being \$52,441. The demographics for the city is 98% being white and 2% being 2 or more races. Most residents speak English (94%) with 6% speaking other languages specifically Spanish. The community is small and has few businesses for families to obtain employment. Most families must travel to find jobs in nearby communities. The community has two dollar stores, 2 gas stations with restaurant's inside. There is one additional restaurant separate from the gas stations. There are 2 body shop/auto repair businesses, one post-office and 2 churches. Farming is abundant in the area. Our student body consists of 156 students with 79% being white, 18% Hispanic and 3% being of 2 or more races. The student body has 77% of all students being categorized as free and reduced lunch. Currently, our district is on a grant for free meals for all students. With such a high number of free and reduced students our GAP area is in Economically Disadvantaged (reading and math). We provide after school tutoring to any student needing serviced through our 21st Century program. We have daytime ESS, Reading Recovery, TAG, ELL services and intervention to assist us in meeting needs. We are a Title 1 school and work diligently to make sure that we meet the needs of our students each day whether it is academic or other. Our district provides students within our building chromebooks. We are one to one with technology. Access to Internet is better than it has been over the past three years. Rural areas are being better serviced with Satellite Internet. We still have a few students who do not have access to internet. They can access internet at the library in Paris which is approximately 25 minutes away. We have availability to internet from our parking lot but only for our school devices.
